Youth talked with Representative Lyman about prevention concerns in their communities.

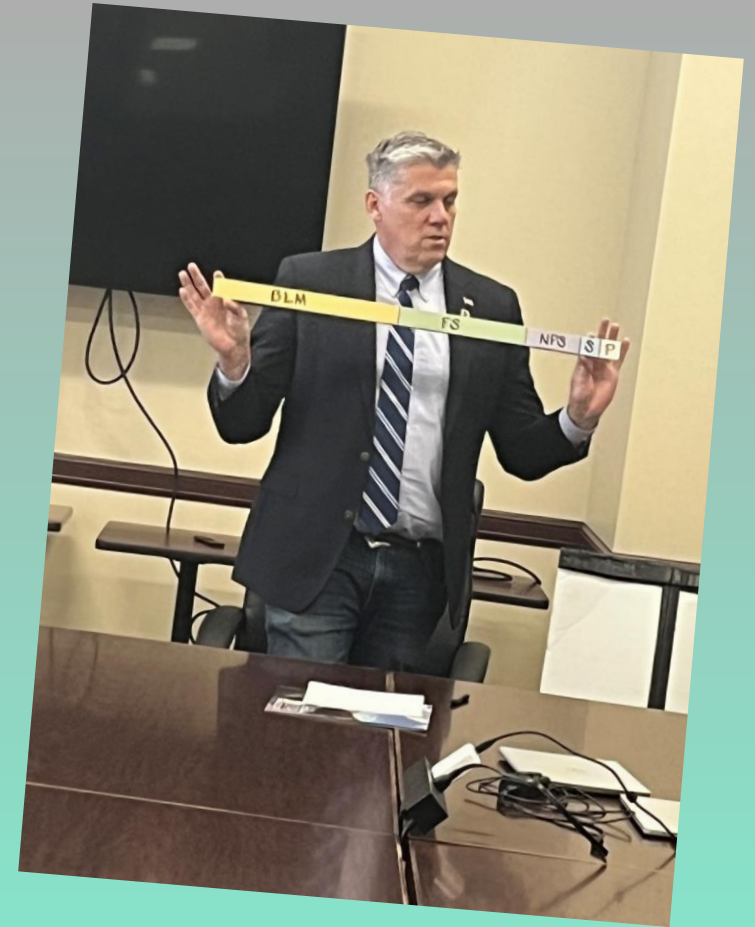


“Yellowcake” (Uranium) refers to local San Juan County resources

Representative Lyman and his wife Jody, showed the students an overlay of Public Lands in San Juan County...

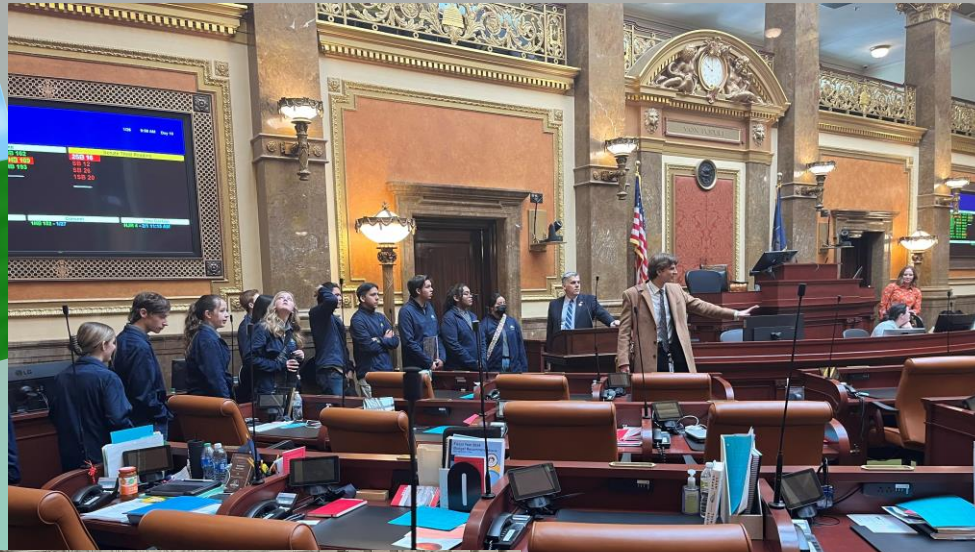
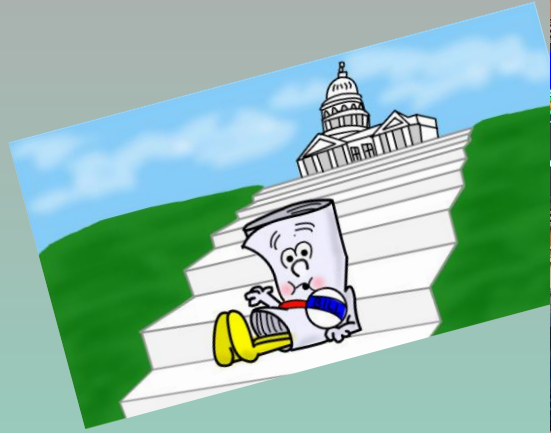


...and the percentages of our county that are run by other entities and how that impacts our local way of life.

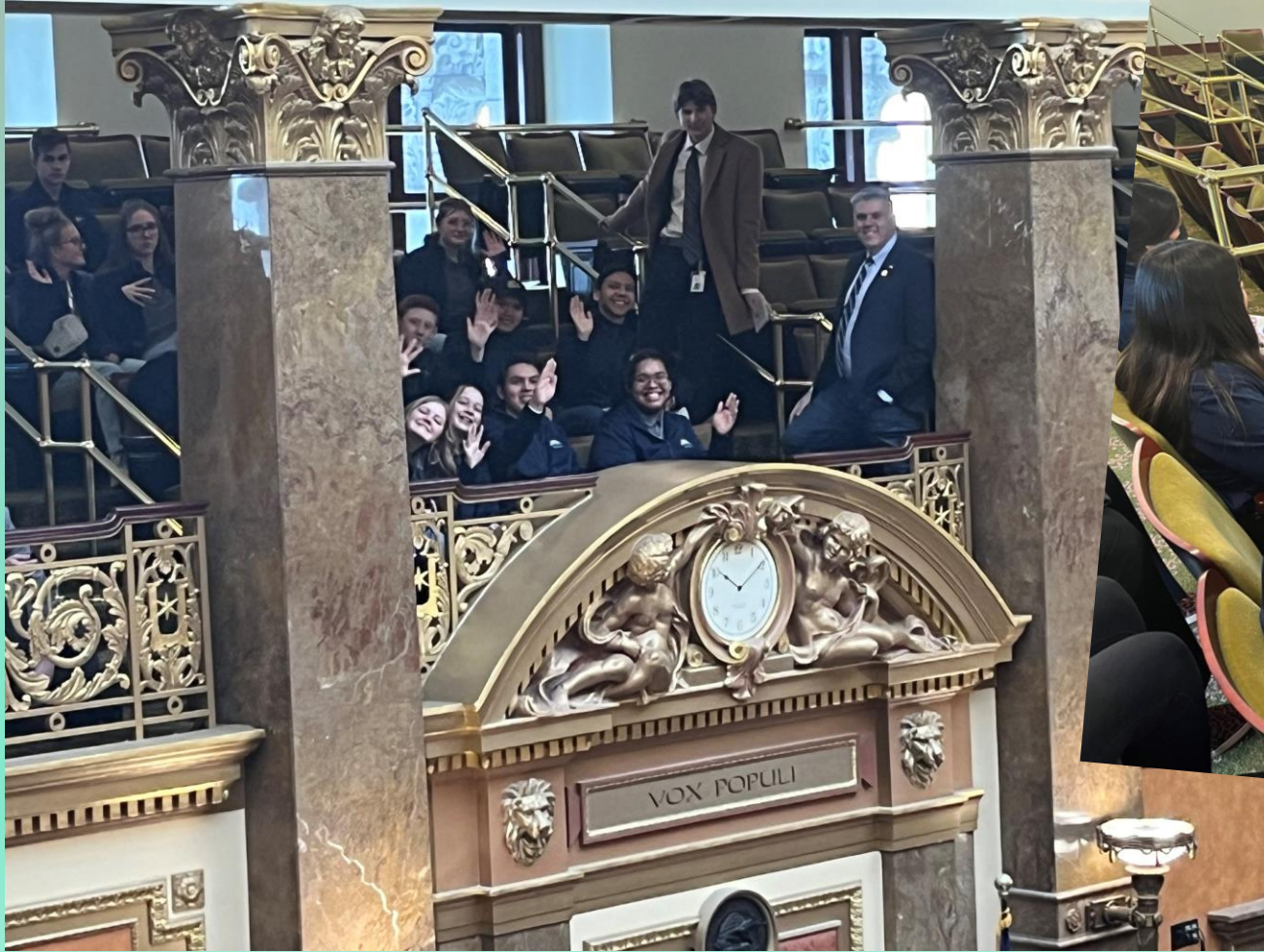

...tour continues in the House Balcony, where Representative Lyman answered questions...





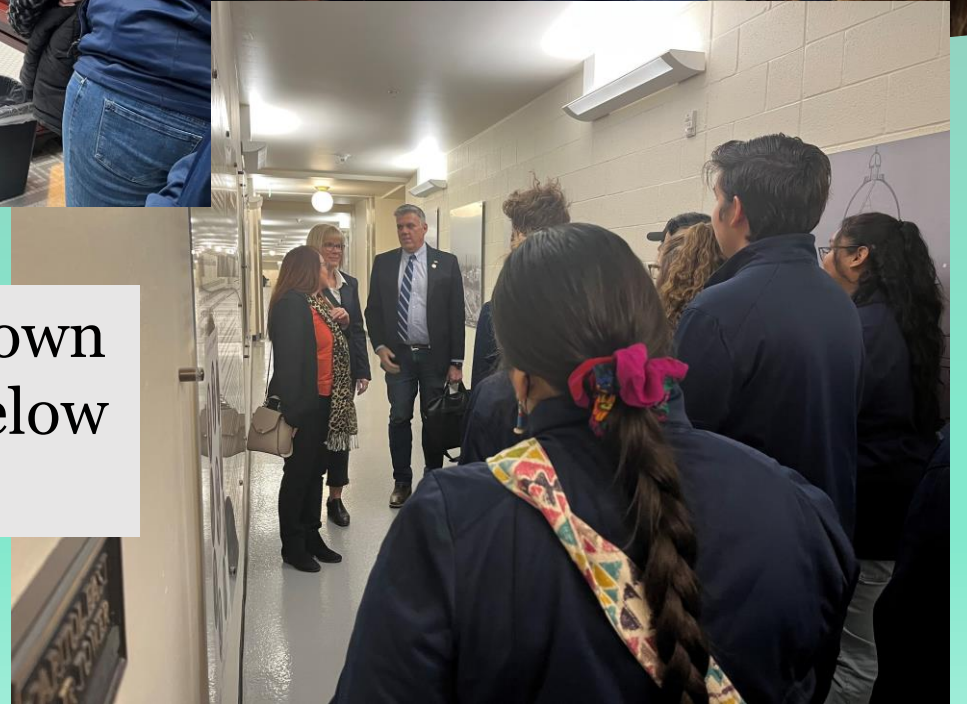
...tour continues into the Hall of Governors...
