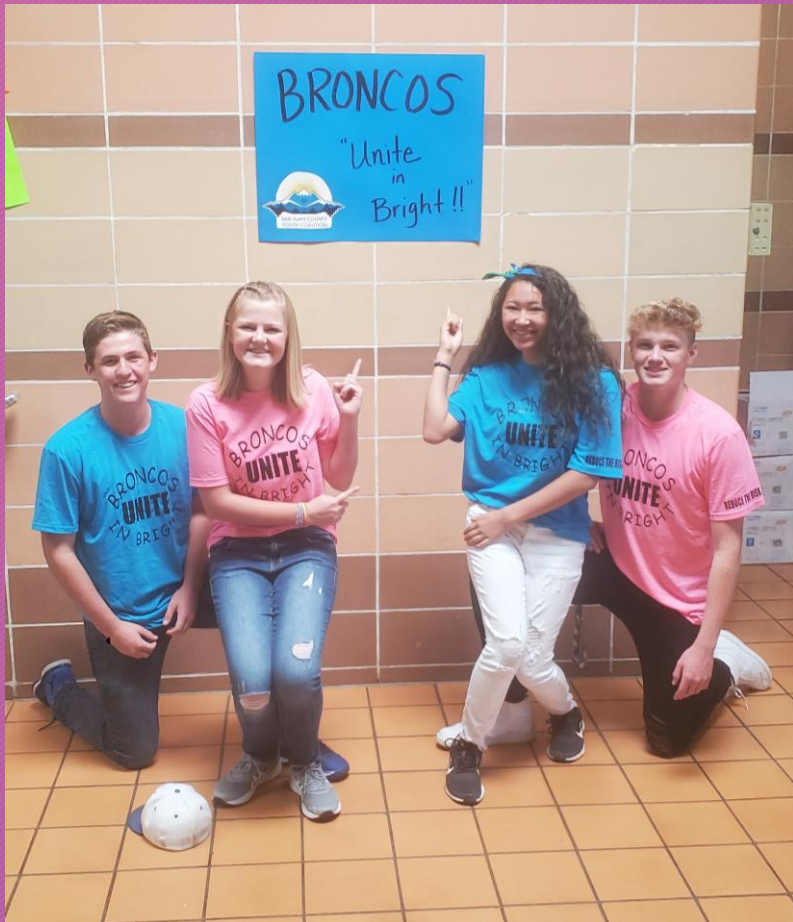

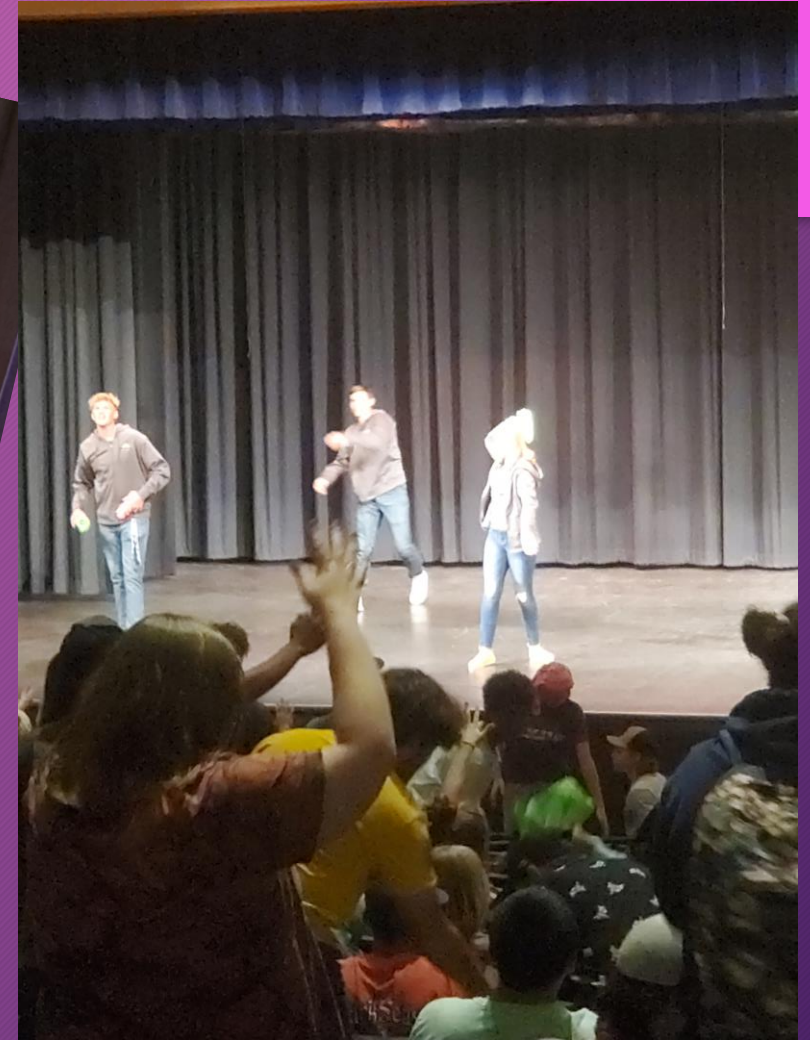
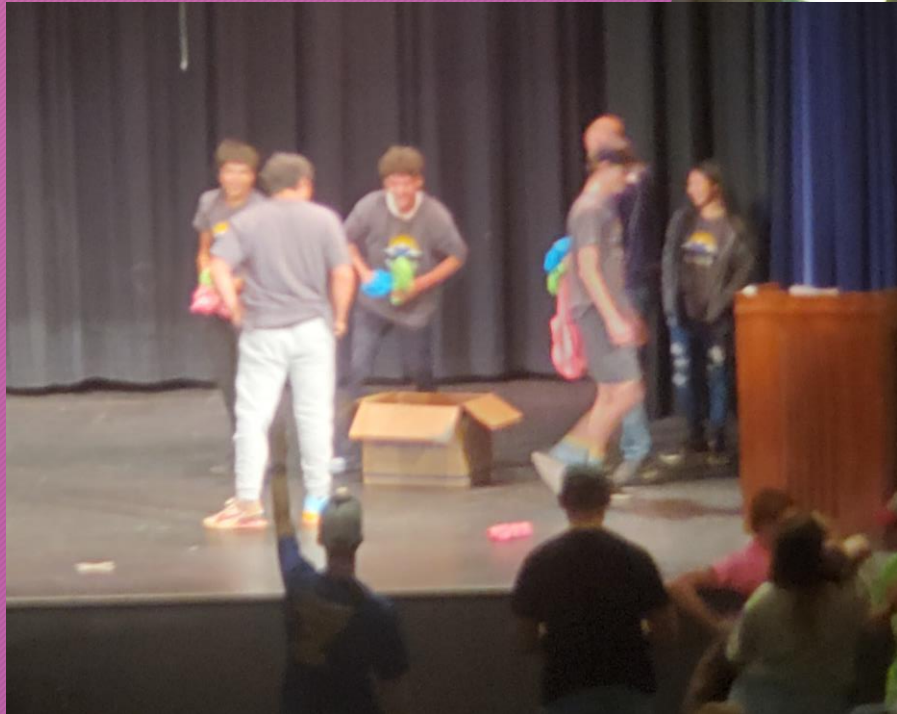
POINTS MADE in the assembly...
